## SCOTT GELLATLY AUGUST 16-19, 2018

Explore the beautiful Skagit valley during this three-day oil painting workshop! The first day will start with a 2-hour Gamblin lecture demonstration on contemporary oil painting materials, which will include a discussion of color palettes, painting mediums, Studio Safety and varnishing. After lunch, we'll spend the rest of the day developing oil sketches en plein air. We'll discuss what makes a successful study for larger studio paintings. On day two we'll work from the field studies back in the studio to develop a larger, more complete painting. Scott Gellatly is a landscape painter living in Portland, OR. His expressive, atmospheric plein air paintings have been exhibited in numerous solo and group exhibitions. His work is represented by Brian Marki Fine Art in Portland. Scott is also the Product Manager at Gamblin Artists Colors in Portland and has lectured and demonstrated across the United States, Canada and Australia. ### Materials:

- Plein Air easel
- Plein Air palette (if not already part of the easel)
- If you use a wood palette, make sure it is sealed and dry before the workshop
- Camping stool to use while painting (optional)
- Brushes: Filbert or Flat, three different sizes.
- Painting Panels:
  - 2 – 3 small panels (i.e. 5" x 7", 6" x 8" or 8" x 10") for painting out in the field.
  - 1 – 2 larger panels (i.e. 16" x 20" or 18" x 24") for studio work.
- Oil Colors: Gamblin oil colors, in the following:
  - Titanium Zinc White or Titanium White 150ml
  - Cadmium Yellow Light 37ml
  - Indian Yellow 37ml
  - Cadmium Red Light 37ml
  - Alizarin Crimson or Alizarin Permanent 37ml
  - Ultramarine Blue 37ml
  - Manganese Blue Hue, Cerulean Blue or Cerulean Blue Hue 37ml
- Painting Medium: Instructor will provide.
- Artist's Thinner: Instructor will provide. Note: Please bring a small brush-washing container. This can be a small glass jar with a lid, if you prefer.
- Rags: Please bring a small handful of clean rags (old t-shirts are fine).
- Sack Lunch
- Water bottle
- Hat, sunscreen
